Province of Manitoba Bill 64 - Resolution of Opposition to Bill

Whereas School Boards are an integral part of Canada's political landscape and have historically built a universally accessible, publicly funded education system, and

Whereas School Boards offer communities the opportunity to engage directly with local elected representatives and the opportunity to participate in developing a vision for education allowing communities the ability to advocate for their local educational values and the ability to hold representatives directly accountable for student achievement and focus on equitable access to education, and

Whereas School Boards reflect the unique values and needs of the local community through specialized programming, essential services, and specialized support systems offered to the individuals they serve, and

Whereas the School Boards operate on a transparent, open mandate that encompasses community involvement and open dialogue that builds the trust necessary for good governance; and

Whereas the Province of Manitoba's proposed Bill - 64 will eliminate local School Boards and the critical role that they play in making local decisions, removing a key aspect of Manitoba's democratic system with no public referendum; and

Whereas School Boards ensure that the vast majority of locally

raised taxes remain spent in local businesses while the Province of Manitoba's proposed Bill - 64 will remove tax dollars from our rural communities to be spent at large businesses by a central purchasing division based in Winnipeg, and on unelected bureaucrats of education setting direction from Winnipeg; and

Whereas other Provincial Initiatives aimed at centralization have resulted in drastic reductions in service to our agricultural sector and health care sectors;

Therefore be it resolved that Council for the Mossey River Municipality hereby oppose Bill 64 - The Education Modernization Act and request the Province of Manitoba to amend Bill - 64 so that its legislation will maintain the rights of the education community and associated stakeholders to democratically elect local representatives to local school boards.
